

The American Film Institute Conservatory, a two (2) year MFA graduate filmmaking program, seeks a part-time Therapist to work one night per week from 6:00pm – 9:00pm conducting counseling sessions as needed for Fellows (students) on campus in a private office setting. The therapist will report to the Office of Fellow Affairs and all scheduling will be done for them. This is a contract position at a rate commensurate with a non-profit school.

Candidates should have a Master's degree in Social Work, Counseling or related field AND be licensed to practice in the state of California. Experience working with clients on anxiety-reduction techniques, stress management and conflict resolution, as well as resource-oriented candidates with clinical experience working with diverse populations are highly preferred. Experience with the performance-based arts or film production is preferred, but not required.
