## PAT HITCHCOCK AT AFI SILVER THEATRE AND CULTURAL CENTER JULY 25 & 26

### Alfred Hitchcock's Daughter to Launch "Hitchcock At Universal" Film Series with On-Stage Discussions

**Silver Spring, Maryland, July 23, 2003** —The American Film Institute (AFI) will present two live, on-stage discussions with Pat Hitchcock, daughter of the late Alfred Hitchcock, on Friday, July 25 and Saturday, July 26 at the AFI Silver Theatre and Cultural Center in Silver Spring, MD.

On July 25 and 26, actress/producer Pat Hitchcock will open the AFI Silver's "Hitchcock at Universal" series honoring her father—director and "Master of Suspense"—Alfred Hitchcock. Hitchcock's live stage discussions about her father's work—as well as what it was like to be his daughter and to be directed by him—will accompany both the July 25, 8:30 p.m. screening of STRANGERS ON A TRAIN and the July 26, 8:15 p.m. presentation of STAGE FRIGHT (in both of which she performed).

The "Hitchcock at Universal" July 25-August 6 series will feature screenings of Hitchcock's Universal Studios classics—FAMILY PLOT, FRENZY, TORN CURTAIN, THE BIRDS, TOPAZ and MARNIE.
